PDB Clubs are to have all paperwork at the Branch office no later than midday on Monday 12 February 2012 for processing.

CONDITIONS AND RULES

- This carnival will be conducted in accordance with the 33rd Edition of the Surf Sports Manual including amendments and bulletins
- APPEALS
Clubs may appeal a dismissed protest to the Appeals Committee. A fee of \$110.00 must be lodged. If the appeal is upheld the fee will be returned. If the appeal is dismissed the fee is retained by Point Danger Branch

- All competitors must be current financial and proficient members of their Surf Life Saving Club

LATE ENTRY FEES & PROCEDURES

Carnival Close Date : Tuesday 14th February 2012 at **MIDNIGHT.**

Additional Entries : Wednesday 15th February – Wednesday 22nd February 2012 at **MIDDAY.**

Any additions or changes will be accepted within the above timeframe without incurring a late entry fee. Clubs are to contact Point Danger Branch to add these in.

Late Entries : These will take effect from Wednesday 22nd February 2012 at 12:01pm at which time the marshal sheets will be printed. Late entries will be charged as below

On Carnival Day : If a competitor is already entered in other events on the program and wishes to enter into another event on the day, he/she will not be required to pay any monies. This entry will still need to be submitted by the times listed below.

For competitors not entered in the carnival, a late entry fee will be charged of \$44 per person + \$5.50 per person. If there is an entire team, each member of the team that is not entered in the carnival, will be required to pay \$44 per person + \$5.50 per person.

TEAM MANAGER DECLARATIONS

The attached Team Manager Declarations MUST be completed by all Clubs and sent to the Branch before the start of the event. No clubs will be eligible to start the carnival without a completed Team Manager's Declaration.

All Clubs need to be aware that Team Managers must have a current Working With Children Check 'Blue Card'.

Team Managers Declarations must be given to the Branch prior to the competitors entering the competition. Any club that has not provided their Team Managers Declaration prior to the carnival start time will be excluded from competition. Please note that the declaration MUST be signed by two club Executive Officers i.e. President, Secretary, Treasurer, Club Captain etc. Office Bearers of the Junior Activity Committee (excluding the Chairperson) and Club Administrators are not Executive Officers

GENERAL

All clubs are to respect the signs located on the beach in regards to tents on the dunes. Any clubs that fails to follow the signs will be asked to move their tent.

As per advice from the Board of Junior Activities each competitor will be given a "participation medal". These will be available for collection from the Branch office in the week after the Carnival. An e-mail will be sent to all clubs advising them of the availability of medals.

IRB AND WATER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- A random draw will be carried out and the two (2) clubs that are drawn out will be required to provide and fully equipped and serviceable IRB with driver and crew. All IRB's shall be inspected by the carnival IRB Coordinator and if found to be unserviceable will be rejected and the Club shall provide a replacement.
- The fully kitted IRB will need to be available at the host club by 6:00am on Sunday morning for the duration of the carnival.
- Failure of clubs to provide the boat and crew on time will result in all competitors from that club being withdrawn from the Carnival.
- Clubs will be sent a roster for water safety once the entries have closed. Clubs will be required to have 1 : 15 ratio for water safety personnel.
- All water safety MUST be registered and hold a proficient SRC or Bronze Medallion. They are required to sign on during the day and their status will be checked throughout the day.

**SPECIAL NOTICE TO ALL TEAM MANAGERS AND CLUB EXECUTIVE
PDB U8 – U10 JUNIOR CARNIVAL**

At various meetings of the State Centre, reports of misbehavior at Surf Carnivals have been noted with grave concern. The Australian Council has resolved that each Team Manager be notified by special notice of his obligations and responsibilities to his club, and to Surf Life Saving Australia.

It is an express condition of acceptance of club entries for the PDB U8-U10 JUNIOR CARNIVAL that the club's Team Manager signs this certificate, verifying that he has read and will do everything in his power to comply with this notice. Each club is now requested to ensure the following items and conditions are implemented:-

1. Each club travelling to the PDB U8 – U10 Junior Titles shall have a Team Manager duly appointed by the club in resolution or action.
2. The Team Manager shall be held responsible to the club and to the SLSA for the conduct of all his team members in travelling to, during, and returning home from the PDB U8 – U10 Junior carnivals
3. Any group of two or more members who depart the main body of the team (for purposes of travel or any other reason) shall have a Sub-Manager appointed by the Team Manager for the duration of their departure.
4. Team Managers shall, at all times, exercise control over their teams and ensure member's conduct and appearance does not have an adverse bearing upon the good name of his club nor the Association.
5. Special care is to be exercised at high-density congregation points, especially air or bus terminals and during the trip. Air Navigation orders lay down procedures as regards intoxication, interference to air crews, disorderly or offensive behaviour, and any act that threatens the safety of the aircraft. Any person contravening this order is guilty of an offence.
6. Before departing your accommodation point - the Team Manager shall conduct an inspection of the rooms accompanied by the Manager, and preferably a senior member of the team. It shall be confirmed that no complaints are being made, nor will be made re the team's conduct or conditions of accommodation fixtures.
7. A report shall be furnished to the club by the Team Manager immediately following the completion of the Championships (within 14 days) and report any misconduct or complaint.
8. Team Managers should be cautious of the exchange of team uniforms during or at the Carnival, as mis-reporting of incidents may occur.
9. Remember that the venue of the PDB U8 – U10 Junior Carnival is the traditional support base for local clubs and any misconduct will certainly be noticed and jeopardize future activities of those clubs. You can readily imagine the situation applied in reverse.
10. The Host Branch have been instructed to form a Judiciary Committee which will hold itself ready for a meeting in the event of any complaint. Such Committee shall have the power to also act at the time and shall have jurisdiction over any Lifesaver attending the State Titles or associated Carnivals held at that time.
11. Team Managers should wear club shirts sign written with "TEAM MANAGER".
