FACT SHEET: ONLINE CERTIFICATE II /BRONZE MEDALLION

HISTORY

Surf Life Saving has been training members in the Bronze Medallion since its inception in 1907. This award is central to our history, our traditions and our organisation.

In 2004 there was a change in this award – with the addition of a Certificate II Pubic Safety (Aquatic Rescue).

CURRENT

When members seek to join a club and patrol they then embark on training for the Bronze Medallion/ PUA21012 Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue),

The training for this course will last for approximately 40 hours face to face depending on current skills and knowledge and fitness levels, and incorporate all theoretical and practical knowledge towards set learning outcomes.

Members now have the opportunity to do the theory component on line.

HOW TO DO YOUR THEORY ON LINE

1. SLSA MEMBERS PORTAL ACCOUNT

2. FIND ON-LINE COURSE

Select "Memberships" dropdown and then "Courses" on the sub menu
